Bruce Page is the Chief Information Officer (CIO) for Savannah River Nuclear Solutions (SRNS). He is responsible for all facets of Information Technology (IT) services provided by SRNS in support of both the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) and DOE-Environmental Management missions at the Savannah River Site.

A seasoned IT professional with 39 years of technical experience, Page began his career at SRS in 1975 as a coal handler in the Power Department. He later worked in Reactor Operations and served as an operations supervisor, overseeing reactor charge/discharge processes. His career progression led to him joining the technical procedures team, leading the Reactor department's transition from paper-based operations to a digital workspace equipped with personal computers throughout the organization. After this, he joined the central IT department, taking on leadership roles and spearheading transformative initiatives, enhancing conduct of operations, and modernizing disaster recovery strategies.

In 2015, Page joined the NNSA-managed MOX Project as Deputy IT Manager and later Director. He returned to SRNS in 2019 reporting to the CIO, and assumed the role of CIO in 2024.
