EXPERIENCE

Mark Davis is Acting Senior Vice President of National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Operations and Programs for Savannah River Nuclear Solutions (SRNS) at the Department of Energy's (DOE) Savannah River Site. In this role, he is responsible for Tritium Operations and Programs, as well as Nuclear Nonproliferation Programs.

Prior to his current position, Davis served as Deputy Vice President of NNSA Operations and Programs for SRNS.

Davis has almost 40 years of experience in nuclear operations, including a 36-year career in the U.S. Navy prior to his retirement as a Captain in June 2017. In his final tour in the Navy, he served on the staff of the DOE Deputy Secretary, first as the Senior Advisor for Nuclear Affairs and then as the Deputy Chief of Staff. During the transition of the Administration, he served as the Chief of Staff for the Acting Secretary of Energy.

Davis commanded two nuclear-powered submarines in addition to serving as the Commodore of Task Force Six Nine in Naples, Italy. Ashore, he served as the Navy's Deputy Chief of Legislative Affairs in the Pentagon and as the Force Nuclear Power Officer on the U.S. Submarine Force Staff located in Norfolk, Va.
