CSRA Children to Receive Over 7,000 Toys from SRNS Employees during “Toys for Tots” Campaign

AIKEN, S.C. (Dec. 5, 2012) – Christmas morning will be brighter for many families throughout the greater Aiken-Augusta area with the addition of a new toy or special present for many of the region’s less fortunate children this year due to the generosity of thousands of Savannah River Nuclear Solutions (SRNS) employees.

More than 7,300 toys were donated this year by SRNS workers for the Savannah River Site (SRS) U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots Program and 1,800 gifts for the Site’s Salvation Army Angel Program.

“It touches my heart, how each year our employees see the need and answer the call to make a child so happy on Christmas day,” said Julie Kirby, SRNS employee and SRS Toys for Tots Chair. “Since 2009, over 23,000 donated toys have magically appeared in the hundreds of donation boxes placed around the site.”

SRNS personnel manage the Toys for Tots and Salvation Army Angel Programs each year during the SRS campaign. “The vast majority of the resources for this highly appreciated effort are provided by SRNS workers who just want to give back,” added Kirby.
